

Slovakia at the INNOPROM 2019 fair in Yekaterinburg

Slovak Investment and Trade Development Agency (SARIO) from July 8 – 11, 2019 prepared for nine Slovak small and medium-sized companies an opportunity to be a part of a joint exhibition stand of the Slovak Republic under the visual brand GOOD IDEA SLOVAKIA at one of the most important international industrial fairs in the Russian Federation - INNOPROM 2019 in Yekaterinburg.

INNOPROM is one of the most important fairs of its kind in the Russian Federation and CIS region (Commonwealth of Independent States), with more than 600 exhibitors from 20 countries in the fields of metalworking, industrial automation, mechanical engineering, and power engineering. The central theme of this year's jubilee exhibition was 'digital production - integrated solutions'.
